
## Sources of funding

More than 96 percent of CDS funding is realized through grants and contracts from federal and state agencies, non-profit organizations, foundations, businesses, and fees. Included in the federal portion is \$577,449 from the <u>Administration for Community Living</u>, <u>Administration on Disabilities</u> for our core funding as a <u>University Center for</u> <u>Excellence in Developmental Disabilities</u>. This U.S. government organization is responsible for implementation of the <u>Developmental Disabilities</u> Assistance and Bill of Rights Act of 2000. CDS also benefits from gifts made by individuals and organizations.
